

2018 Home Run Pool Rules

1. Everyone will choose six players as a “team”. Your top six players determine your total at the end of the year. Simply put, the end of the year stats will be your top six players and you will not need to make any switches. For the monthly pool, your top six players at the end of every month will determine who wins a particular month just like the end of year.
2. Per team, the entry fee is \$100 with \$300 of total pot covering the website costs.
3. The order of selection of each team will be determined by the dealing of cards
4. Based on 9 teams, the selection order will be as follows:
 - Round 1: 1-9
 - Round 2: 9-1
 - Round 3: 1-9
 - Round 4: 9-1
 - Round 5: 1-9
 - Round 6: 9-1
5. The winning team will be determined by the most total homeruns of its six hitters. If there is a tie, the winning team will be determined by the most homeruns by the bottom two home run hitters, draft picks 6 and 5.. If they are tied, the total homeruns by each subsequent reverse hitter (4, 3, 2, and 1) will be added to the total of the first two hitters to determine the winning team. If the total remains a tie, the teams will split the first two prizes.
6. For ten minutes after the selection process, teams will be able to trade players or pick off the remaining players on the top 150 list. (No money! Players only!)
7. A percentage of the entry fee goes towards the Monthly pool. This is separate from the yearly total. The person who has the most homeruns during each month of the season will be awarded the prize. The same tiebreaker rule for the regular season will be used in the event of a tie for the month.
8. Home Runs accumulated in the month of March will be tallied in the April totals and home runs accumulated in the month of October will be tallied in the September totals.
9. Prizes are as follows:

First Prize: \$230

Second Prize: \$100

Third Prize: \$60

Monthly Payout: \$35
